Richmond 25 May 1784

This is to Certify that I Mathew Scott of Lincoln County [KY] have Bargain'd & sold unto William Scott of the said County all my Rights, Claims, interest, or Demands whatsoever against the public for services done in the Continental Army & I do hereby Authorise the said William Scott to receive & settle with the Auditors of Public Acco'ts for the same he having paid me for the clame, the receipt whereof I do hereby Acknowledge in testemoney whereof I have hereunto Set My Hand this Twenty Seventh day of February 1784.
