Richmond May 29<sup>th</sup> 1783 I do hereby Certify that the Barrer Wm Ailstock was Discharg'd. the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1780 & that he was a gunner & has served the terms or three years in the State Artillery Com'd. by Colo. Thos Marshall [Thomas Marshall] G Johnson Capt [Gideon Johnson] (Copy [illegible signature])

NOTE: The 1820 federal census for Louisa County lists "Ailstock William (FN)" as a free person of color.
