I Alexander C Shackelford [possibly Alexander Shackelford, pension application S7506] of the county of King & Queen state of Virginia being now in the 74th year of my age do certify and declare that I was well acquainted with William Edwards of Gloucester County that he enlisted in Capt Michen Boswells [sic: Machen Boswell, pension application R19364] company of the second state regiment of the revolutionary war commanded by Col. Wm Brent [William Brent] that he was at the battle of monmouth [28 Jun 1778] that he served for three years in the revolutionary war and untill the end of the war and was honourably discharged as witness my hand and seal this 22nd day of June 1833
