William Trabue Serg't in 11<sup>th</sup> Virg'a. Regt haveing served three years the term for which he was Enlisted is hereby Discharged from the Continential Army Given under my hand this 5<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1780 William Davies Col. Com't. [Colonel Commandant]
