I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8<sup>th</sup> of June 1786." I do hereby Certify that Sergeant William Hendren was enlisted into the Third Regiment of Light Dragoons the 7 June 1781 to serve during the War & that he was a Sergeant in the first Regiment Light Dragoons at the time when it was disbanded, he was appointed a Sergeant the [indecipherable]<sup>1</sup> July 1781
