General Hospital Yellow Spring [near Valley Forge PA] Aug 12th 1784

Samuel Chavis of the Tenth Virg'a Regim't a patient in the Hospital was well recovered and his time nearly out as apears from a Cal't[?] of his enlistment in his posession [illegible word] is herby discharged and permited to go home to Virginia his Reg't being a great way of distance and his home so near Expected that it will be out before he Reaches his home. The Comanding officer in Virg'a is Requested to Excuse this Certificate and give him such Discharge from his Rigm't as will [two illegible words] him [illegible word] not Being molested there Sam'l Hopkins [Samuel Hopkins]
