To the hble the Speaker & Gent of the House of Delegates

The Pet'n. of Capt. Thos. Rowland on behalf of himself & Company – Humbly sheweth. that Your Pet'r. & Company was ordered to the Holstons river [sic: Holston River] by ye County Lieut. of Botetourt, for the relief of the Frontiers & a Garrison said to be besieged, & that in Consequence of the supposed distressed situation of the people your Pet'r. & Comp'y were ordered to take Horses to ride as it was judged footmen could not get out in Time. Therefore y'r. Petitioner prays that the Auditors may be directed to allow pay for the service of said Horses. & they will Pray &c

ref'd June 4th reasonable Allowed 7/3 pr Day for their Horses for the Time specified in the Roll reported June 9th 177 [sic]
