Patrick Henry for an annual pension of 12 Pounds to be paid to Elizabeth Toomy of Frederick County, widow of Matthew Toomy. Other documents include receipts signed by Elizabeth Toomy with her mark.]

I do with advice of Council hereby certify that Elizabeth Toomey, widow of Matthew who was a private in the eighth Virginia Regiment and died in the service of the United States, is continued on the list of Pensioners with an allowance of twelve pounds yearly commencing the first day of January, one thousand seven hundred and ninety five.

Given under my hand as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia at Richmond this 20th day of June 1796.

Frederick Sct February Court 1806

Ordered that the Sherif do pay unto Elizabeth Toomy forty Dollars the Amount of her pension for the last year, and it is further ordered that it be Certified that the said Elizabeth Toomy departed this life on the 16th day of July last.
