[The following is from bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia.]

I certify that Thomas Trent enlisted with me the  $22^{nd}$  day of February 1777 for the Term of three years, he acted as a Serjeant & was discharged on account of the wounds he rec'd at the battle of Monmouth. Given under my hand the  $2^d$  Feby 1784. [Samuel Jones]
