[The following are from <u>pension records in the Library of Virginia</u>. Parts of some images are missing. The following are representative. Apparently Euphan Tumbling was the widow of James Tumbling, who died in service.]

At a court of quarterly session held for Norfolk county the 15th day of November 1790. Ordered that the sherif pay Euphan Tumlin eight pounds instead of 48/. allowed her in April 1788 for her pension, she then made oath to her claim. A copy Teste Jno. Boush cnc

November the 10 1790 Rec'd. the Within of the Sheriff of Norfolk. Eupan herXmark Tumlin

At a court of quarterly Session held for Norfolk county the 15th day of November 1791. Ordered that the sherif pay Euphan Tumlin eight pounds being the amount of her pension for the year 1789. it now appearing to the court that she was before them in April 1789 when an order was made to this effect but has since died – and this is in lieu thereof. a copy Jno. Boush cnc
