Westmoreland County State of Virginia to Wit

Be it known [two undeciphered words] Robert Bailey Justice of the peace in and for said County [several undeciphered words] Job Self aged 63[?] years made Oath in due form of Law that he was well acquainted with Jeremiah Alderson and well knows that the said Alderson served in the army of the Revolution for and during the War and that the said Alderson went into the army under Capt George Turbeville [George Lee Turberville (Turbervile) BLWt2153-300] [several undeciphered words] different States that he verily believes that the said Alderson was either kill'd or died in the army as he never Return'd nor has never been heard of since

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand [undeciphered word] this 6 day of may 1831
