aged 81 years who being first duly sworn according to Law testifies and declares as follows Viz – that he
was a soldier under Captn Thomas Ewell [Thomas Winder Ewell BLWt2497-300] of the 1st Va Reg't state
line Geo Gibson [George Gibson] Col. and served 3 years – going out in 1776 and returning in 1779 –
that Benjamin Atchison dec'd [see endnote] 1st Sergeant of s'd Ewells company, and Joseph Gilbert
[S40059] a private, went out at the time he did (1776) in s'd Company and served faithfully for 3 years
and were honorably discharged.
