Allison [John Allison W4112] of John Wilson Austin having served as a Serjeant three years in the first Virginia State Regiment & another Certificate from Robert Andrews a Justice of the said County of the said Austin's having made Oath before him of his never before proving, or claiming his Right to Land for the Service aforesaid were produced & was ordered to be certified & recorded Ben [undeciphered] Cl[?]

Richmond Ap'1 26th 1783

This may Certify that John Wilson Austin enlisted as Serjeant major in the Service of this State in October 1775 & is now discharged by order of Government,
