[The following are from <u>bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia</u> indexed as Bailey, Ishmail. The index shows Bailey, Ishman as a variant name. Ishmael Bailey W5779, also of Buckingham County, appears to be a different soldier.]

This is to Certify that I was well acquainted with Ishman Bailey whilst a Continental Soldier [three undeciphered words] Island he was in Continental Service at the South I believe that he was made Prisoner at the Capitulation of Charles Town in the State of South Carolina [Charleston, 12 May 1780] Given under my hand this 12th day of November 1811.

Certificate in/ favor of Ishmael/ Bailey

At a court cont'd & held for Buckingham county the 13th day of November 1811 This certificate was produced in court by Ishman Bailey, and Edward Hall being sworn & examined [undeciphered word] that the said certificate contained the truth, & the said Bailey being [two or three undeciphered words] to the truth of the said certificate & [undeciphered word] that he has received no bounty in land for his services, nor had he, or any other person for him ever asserted or set up any claim to such bounty lands.

It does not appear from the books in this office that a warr[an]t has issued to Ishmael Bailey – A warrant issued the 25th January 1809 for the Service of Isme Bailey for a 3 years service as a Serjeant which Warrant was delivered Thomas M.
