This is to Certify that Noah Bailey a Soldier Belonging to the First Virg'a State Reg't. has serve the term of three years Given Under My hand at ye City of Wmsburg this the 22nd Day of May 1780

This Day came before me the above named Noah Bailey & made oath to the authenticity of the above Certificate, & that he has never taken, [undeciphered word] or claimed his Right to Land for the service mentioned in the same [several undeciphered words] at Williamsburg this 1st Day of June 1780. Robert Andrews

I Noah Baily of the first Virginia State Regiment do hereby certify that for & in Consideration of the Sum of Thirty Pounds Ten Shillings to me in hand Paid, the receipt whereof I do Acknowledge, have Sold unto Mr. James Henry of the City of Williamsburg my right to all Lands that I am entitled to by a resolution of assembly granting Lands to Soldiers serving three years in the said Regiment.
