William Boughton Soldier of the second Virginia Regiment having served the full time for which he was inlisted, is hereby discharged from the service. Given under my hand at the Camp at [blank] this 30<sup>th</sup> August 1779. Wm Woodford Brig'r Gen'l.

At a Court held for Essex County at Tappa. [Tappahannock] on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1780.

This Certificate of William Boughton from under the hand of Gen'l. William Woodford, was sworn to by the said Boughton, and ordered to be Recorded.

This is to certify that the second Virginia Regiment mentioned in the within discharge signed by General Woodford must have been intended for the Second Virginia Continental Regiment as the within mentioned William Boughton served under my command as Capt in that Regiment in the year 177[last digit undeciphered]
