Ballard Smith of the infantry attached to the 3rd Regiment of Continental Light Dragoons (see http://revwarapps.org/b137.pdf)]

I hereby Certify that John Brockus Soldier in the Virg'a line and in Continental Service from March[?] 1779 [one or two undeciphered words] 1783. Certified under my hand this [the rest illegible; the index card says that one document was signed by Joseph Conway.]
