I Do hereby Certify that Matthew Burk inlisted in my Company of the 4th Virginia Regiment the 20th Day of February 1776, in which he serv'd faithfully untill September 1779 when he was Taken Prisoner by the British & Remaind A prisoner two year, which was till September 1781, which ended the period which he was Inlisted for, all which time I know him to be Intitled to every emolument with other Continental Soldiers. Given under my hand this 1st of October 1784
