Petition for Add'l bounty land.

The heirs of Wm Burk Sold'r.

This soldier has been allowed 200 acres of land. His heirs claim 200 acres additional: alleging, that he enlisted for the war, before April 1^{st} 1781, and served to the end of it.

The Petition refers to a document, which is not in my office – to wit – to the voucher, or evidence, on which Warrant No 3607 issued, for 200 acres of land. The Register of the land office will furnish a Copy of this document, if required.
