The affidavit of Henry Buchanan [S37807] being of lawful age taken this the 11th day of December 1839 at his residence in the County of York before me Robert Shield a Justice of the Peace of said County & the affiant being duly sworn saith: that he was perfectly acquaint with John Burnham of Warwick county. that the said Burnham was an officer in the Revolutionary war and to the best of his belief was a second Lieutenant in the State Cavalry in which Corps he served some time previous and to the end of the War under Colonel Nelson [Major John Nelson W5414] who commanded the same. Given under my hand the day and date above writen.

Feb. 28th Advised to be rejected. The evidence is that of a single witness given as long ago as 1839 and which is quite vague and uncertain as to the service No Proof in this case – Rejected/ J B Floyd [Gov. John B. Floyd] 1857 March 1 Rejected
