Report upon the claim of Peter Godin – soldier in the Illinois Regiment, for bounty land, for his services.

To the Governor

Sir. This soldiers name is not on the Illinois Payrolls, or muster-rolls, which have been preserv'd; and it is not on the army Register of the State line.

The evidence of the claim which has been relied upon by the Petitioner, is the certificate of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Monroe County – state of Illinois – that Peter Godin (as was proven to the satisfaction of the said Court, in open Court) was a private in the Illinois Regiment for the war of the Revolution; and that he serv'd between three and four years, when the Regiment was discharg'd – (see the certificate of David Nowlin Clk &c)
