William Challis a soldier of infantry in the Va line on continental establishment, received on the 21 May 1784 by Rob't Challis, a certificate for £36.8. for the balance of his full pay or depreciation; and Minson Proby a Sarjeant of Cavalry in the same line received by George Booker, a certificate for £71.5.2 which issued on the 14 April 1785 Given under my hand at the Auditors office this 12th March 1832
