To the Executive of Virginia

the heirs of Samuel Campbell respectfully submit to you their claim for additional bounty land, for services rendered by the s'd Campbell as Lieutenant in the war of the Revolution & submit a certificate from the Register, which shews that the s'd Lieut Campbell died in service they humbly ask that they may be allowed the difference between three years service & service for the war

I hereby certify that it appear from the records in my office that a warrant for 3666²/₃ acres of land issued to William Campbell heir at Law & legal representative of Samuel Campbell who died a Lieutent. in the Continental line of the Revolution, November 13th 1783 Wm Selden R L Off Dec 20 1833
