THESE are to CERTIFY that the bearer hereof Jeremiah Carmine a private in the first Reg't of Light Dragoons Commanded by Col George Baylor, having faithfully served the United States from the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1781 and being inlisted for the war, is hereby discharged from the American army. Given at the war office the 10<sup>th</sup> Da of March 1784

THE within CERTIFICATE shall not avail the bearer of a discharge, until the ratification of the definitive treaty of peace; previous to which time, and until proclamation thereof shall be made, he is to be considered as being on furlough. B. LINCOLN.
