[The following is from rejected claims in the Library of Virginia.]

To his Excellency the Governor of Virg'a.

Your memorialist Jas. Carter of the City of Washington respectfully states that he is the sole heir of Thomas Carter – John Carter – and William Carter each of whom enlisted in the Virg'a Cont'l service in the Revolutionary War. They went from Prince Wm. Co. [Prince William County] in the State of Virg'a. your memorialist is not informed for what length of time they enlisted but believes from all he has ever heard that they cont'd to served till the return of gen'l. peace.

He prays that s'd. claims may be referred for examination and that the customary land allowed in such cases may be allowed to him & he will ever pray &c.
