Certifyed that Captain Thomas Catlett entered into the army February 2^d 1776 as an Ensign and continued in service till the 29th day of May 1780 when he was killed in Action [see endnote] June 14th 1783. Samuel Hawes Lt Colo [BLWt1066-450]

NOTE: Capt. Thomas Catlett was killed at the Battle of Waxhaws SC, 29 May 1780.
