Gists [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500] detachment of the Virg'a Line, has served the full time for which he was inlisted & is hereby discharged from the Service, that he has Rec'd his pay in Continental Currency up to the last of November, One thousand seven Hundred & Seventy Nine, since which he has only rec'd Two Dollars in Specie from the D. Com'y Gen'l [Deputy Commissary General] of prisoners Chas. Town [Charleston SC] [one or two illegible words] Given under my hand at [several illegible words] Twenty Fifth day of July [one] Thousand seven Hundred & Eighty One
