City of Richmond To Wit

Before me a magistrate for the said City personally appeared Joseph Childers of Henrico County and made oath, That he was well acquainted with Allen Childers who enlisted in the service of his country in the Revolutionary War as a private of Infantry for the war and served to the end of the said war, under Captain Tarpley White [R18959] of Hanover County on Continental Establishment, said Jos Childers further states, that Allen Childers died without being married, and that Alexander Childers is the brother and only surviving heir at law of the said Allen Childers deceased Given Under my hand this 4th day of March 1834. Thomas Cowles J.P.
