This is to Certify that James Chizham inlisted a Soldier Jan'y 2<sup>nd</sup> 1777 to serve in the 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Continental Regiment for the Term of Three years & that the said Chizham Dec'd [deceased] March 1778. Thomas Fox [BLWt765-300] Capt. Thomas fox

21st April 1784.

NOTE: The rolls of Capt. John Spotswood's company of the 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment list James Chizham, also spelled James Chesham, in the hospital for many months during 1777 and 1778. On the roll for March 1778 "Jas. Chizham" is listed with the remark "Eras'd Out."
