I do Certify that Thomas Clark inlisted in Decr 1776 in the state service for the term of Three years on or before the Expiration of which time he Reinlisted for the War and served as a Souldier in the 1st V State Regt till Decr 1780[?] at which time he was detatchd from the [undeciphered word] & Rid of With Colo Green [John Green BLWt866-500] to join the Southern Army
