I David Nowlin Clerk of the circuit court of said county do certify that it is proven in open court to the satisfaction of said court that the within named Lewis Clermont and Joseph Clermont was privates in the Revolutionary war in the Illinois regiment commanded by Col George Rogers Clarke [sic: George Rogers Clark VAS269] that they served between three and four years when the regiment was discharged and that they never received a warrant or warrants for the bounty land promised them either on the part of the united states or the State of Virginia, nor did they ever transfer their claim to it in any manner whatever and further [undeciphered word] that the said Lewis Clermont and Joseph Clermont died intestate And that the within named parties to this instrument are their only heirs[?]
