I do hereby Certify that William Cocke Inlisted with me for the term of three years as a Soldier in the Continental Army in the late American war with Great Britain the 15<sup>th</sup> Regiment Commanded by Colo'l. David Mason [VAS506]

Given under my hand this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1797. [signature cut off but said to be that of Capt. James Harris VAS1448]

On examining the Muster Roll of the 11<sup>th</sup> Regiment which was formerly the 15<sup>th</sup> I find William Cocke was my first Sergeant in the Company which Cap. James Harris raised in this county which came under my command after his resignation [on 11 Mar 1778] & the said William Cocke served during the term of three years agreeable to his enlistment William Smith
