## Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to John Cole VAS3056 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

[The following is from <u>bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia</u>. The record may refer to two different officers named John Cole, one or both of whom may have been John Cole S39344.]

By reference to the Books of this Office, it appears that on a certificate from the Executive that John Cole was entitled to the proportion of land allowed a Captain of the Continental line for three years service, two warrants, to wit: one No 3041 for 3,000 acres and one No 3042 for 1,000 acres were issued and delivered to John Cole on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1803 which was the date of the Certificate from the Executive. It also appears that on a certificate from the Executive dated the 10<sup>th</sup> June 1783 that a warrant issued to John Cole on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 1784 for 200 acres for his services as a Sergeant in the Virginia Artillery on the continental establishment, three years.
