Westmoreland County State of Va To Wit

Be it known that before me Robert Bailey A Justice of the peace in and for the county aforesaid personally appeared Bennett McKey [S38197] an old Revolutionary Soldier and pentioner of the united States aged 76 years and made oath in due Form of law that he was well acquainted with William Cole and knows that the said William Cole went into the army at the Begining of the Revolutionary War and surved throughout the whole Revolutionary War to the close thereof Given under my hand this first day of June 1781 [signature illegible]
