Orange County 10<sup>th</sup> Aug'st 1811

I hereby Certify that Charles Collier formerly of the County of King & Queen, but at present residin in one of the Southern States, was appointed a first Lieutenant in the army of the United States about the last of Oct'er or first of Nov'r in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy six, & from information which I believe is correct he left the army with the rank of Capt. after serving upwards of three years in one of the Virg'a State Reg't
