On this 20<sup>th</sup>[?] day of September 1833 appeared in person before me [undeciphered] a justice of the peace in and for aforesaid County Hugh Davis [S10136] and George Mills [W7449] age of the former 75 years and latter 78 years who being first duly sworn according to Law do each of them on their respective Oaths state that they well knew William Conner and Douglas Conner, that they [several undeciphered words] aforesaid County – that to their certain knowledge said William and Douglas [several undeciphered words] 1776 [several undeciphered words] 3 years [several undeciphered words] and 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut [undeciphered] & was attached to the [undeciphered] Virg'a Regiment. That they marched [the rest almost entirely illegible
