I Do hereby Certify that thos. Cope a Soldier of my Company who was Cammanded by Collo Edward Stephens [sic: Edward Stevens VAS1922] of the 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Redgment was Inlisted the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of Decm'r 1776 for the Term of three years But in my Absence was Return'd During the war who Appears to have obtained his Discharge the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of Nov'r 1781 at Cumberland Courthouse witness my hand this 19<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1784 David Laird [VAS1839]
