I do hereby Certify that Isaiah Corbin Inlisted as a Soldier in the Revolutionary Army in the year 1776 and that he was wounded in 1777 at quibble Town in New Jersey [Quibbletown (New Market)] & that I presented his discharge from the Continental Army in Consequence of his being found unfit for the service by the said wound which discharge [undeciphered] from Brigadier General Wm Woodford [William Woodford] & that the said Corbin was a Soldier in the Eleventh Virginia Regiment in Continental Service given Under my hand & seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1808

Phil Slaughter [Philip Slaughter W29886] formerly Capt 11<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Reg't I am well satisfied that the above Certificate contains the truth Edward Stevens [VAS1922] formerly Colo of ye 10<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Regim't
