I do hereby Certify that Drury Covey Serj't in Col. Gists [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500] detachment of the Virginia Line has served the full time for which he was Inlisted and is hereby Discharg'd from the Service – that he has Rec'd his pay in Cont'l [Continental] Currency up to the last of November One Thousand seven hundred and Seventy Nine since which he has Only Rec'd Two Dollars in Specie from the D. Com'sy Gen'l [Deputy Commissary General] of Prisoners at Charlestown [Charleston SC, surrendered to the British on 12 May 1780]

Given under my hand at Williamsburgh [Williamsburg] the Twenty fifth day of July One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty One.
