I Hamblin Cole [Hamlin (Hamlen) Cole S39342] of Chesterfield County Virginia do hereby Certify that I was well acquainted with William Cox and know that he enlisted for three years in the Virginia Contineltal Servis in the Revolutionary war and was Slain in the battle at Charlestown South Carolina and the said Cox was a nonCommissioned Officer as I believ and belong to the Fifteenth Regement as I believe given under my hand this 15th of April 1833.
