He went into service in the year 1778[?] and continued upwards of three years in the Sixteenth Virginia Regiment on continental Establishment Given under my Hand this 29<sup>th</sup> day of August 1813 Herod Gibbs Lt 15<sup>th</sup> V Rigt [W17947]

I John Jaco a Soldier in the Sixteenth Rejiment in the Virginia Line in the Revolutionary Ware with Greate Briton do hearby Certify that I knew Thomas Ray as a Captain in The Virginia Line in the Revolutionary ware With Great Britain. I do know he was in that service in the year seventeen hundred and Seventy Eight [several illegible words] Sixteenth Regiment [several illegible words] Given Under my and this 2<sup>d</sup> day of [illegible]
