THIS is to certify that John Cullickan Inlisted[?] in the fusiliers[?] in the First Partisan Legion, under my Command, has served from time to time to this Day, is hereby discharged from the Service of the United States, in Pursuance of Orders received from the Commander in Chief, bearing Date the third instant.

I farther certify that John Cullickan [several undeciphered words] having been [two or three undeciphered words] the State of Virginia is intituled by the Resolution of Congress, of the 13th February, 1779, to the Benefits that have been, or hereafter shall be, granted by the said State to the Noncommissioned Officers and Soldiers of the said Line.

Given under my Hand and Seal at York Town, this fifteenth Day of November, 1783. [illegible signature said to be by Charles Armand BLWt2291-850] Brigadier General Entered in the Books of the Legion.
