Augusta County Sct

This day came before me one of the Justices for the peace of the said County Capt Wm Long [William Long VAS973] and made oath that Geo Cummins enlisted in his Company belonging to the Second Virginia State Regiment Commanded by Col Wm Brent [William Long VAS973] on the first day of May 1777 to serve untill March 1780 & the said Geo Cummins never enlisted afterwards in the service and that in May last, when he attended at Wmsburg to settle the affiars of his Company he applyed to Col Brent for discharges for the soldiers and for the s'd Cummins the Col told him to write Discharges and that he would sign them and that before the discharges could be got Ready Business Called the Col out of Town & that he Could not wait on Exp[resse]s there untill his Return as it was uncertain and that he has never seen the Col. since or had any Instructions from him how to Act
