I Certify that John Watkins enlisted and was appointed a Sergt in the 4<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment of Continental Troops the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1777. was appointed Quarter Masters Serjt. the first day of Jan'y 1778. he served the term of his enlistm't & was discharged the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January 1780 Given under my hand this the 23<sup>d</sup> day of Decem'r 1783 NB he rec'd his pay up to the 1<sup>st</sup> Dec'r 1779 since that time he has rec'd no pay from the Regt Copy.
