These are to Certify that the bearer hereof John Curtis in the first Virginia Regim't having faithfully served the United States from the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 1782 to this Date, and being inlisted for the [illegible, but probably "War, is hereby"] Discharged from the American Army.

Given at Point of Fork [confluence of James and Rivanna rivers] the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of Sept. 1783.

I do Certify that the abovementiond John Curtis has received no more than three Months pay from the 1<sup>st</sup> June 1782 to this date to the best of my knowledge.
