I do Certify that William Daingerfield enlisted the 29<sup>th</sup> August 1777 to serve the term of three years & that he reinlisted in Feb'y 1780 to serve During the War. he continued in actual service untill 12<sup>th</sup> May 1780 at which time he was made prisoner [at the surrender of Charleston SC] & to the Best of my knowledge he Died in Decem'br 1780. he serv'd a Drummer the above time

Jno Roney [John Roney BLWt1856-200] Late Lieut 3<sup>d</sup> Virg'a Reg't.

Aug't 2[?]<sup>th</sup> 1786

Sir Please to send over by Mr Jno Vaughan my Brother William Dangerfield's Certificate Intrust [interest] & Land warrent That is Due to him for his Services in the Continental Army and oblige your Hble Serv't.
