I certify that Jeremiah Davis reenlisted as a Soldier in the 7<sup>th</sup> Vairginia Regiment at White Marsh in the State of Pennsylvania in the Month of Nov'r or Dec'r 1777 and that the terms of his Enlistment I think was for three years or during the War. (The said Davis was Captured at Chas. Town [Charleston SC, 12 May 1780]).

Given under my hand this 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1797.
