This Day came Elijah Buck, before me David Scott sen, one of the Commonwealth Justices, and made oath that Peter Davis is a an heir of John Davis who Died in Battle at Fort Lowrance

I Assign all my wright and title of my Land Warrant unto David Scott Sen, Witness I hereunto Set my hand and seal this 12[?] Day of April 1806 Peter Davas Elijah Runner Bejamin Harrison

I Do hereby certify that John Davis Enlisted as a regular soldier in the thirteenth Virginia under my Command; And was killed in Battle at Fort Laurence [sic: Fort Laurens near present Bolivar OH, 23 Feb 1779]. April 12, 1806 David Scott
