Sam'l. Coleman Esq'r for the present of this Succession, plese to Obtain from the Governor directed to the Register of the Land Office an order what Land may be due me as a Soldier in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim't Artillery Commanded by Colo. Chas. Harrison [Charles Harrison VAS1411] my Servsis dureing the war. And deliver the same to Mr Richard Bowler of Richmond – and Oblige your Obt H'l Servt Nov'r 23<sup>rd</sup>

the above order was given in my Presents being one of the justices of the peace for the County of Mathews[?] Wm Buckner

City of Richmond toWit

This day came Samuel Eddens [Samuel Eddins BLWt683-300] Late Captain of Artillery before me a Justice of the Peace for the City of Richmond and made Oath that he the said Eddens inlistid Rich'd. Davis in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim't of Artillery Commanded by Colo. Charles Harrison, and that the said Davis serv'd until the end of the War, at which time he the said Eddens Dischargd the said Davis agreeable to the Commander in Chiefs Proclamation
