I Do hereby Certify that James Doran Inlisted in the continental army on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1779 for the Term of [several illegible words] enlisted as a Corporal in Capt. Isaiah Marks [R16055] Company of Col Bufords Batt'n when it was defeat'd at the Waxsaws in South Carolina [sic: Abraham Buford S46372 defeated at the battle of Waxhaws, 29 May 1780] and afterwards joind at Chesterfield old court House & went out under the comm'd [illegible] Buford to the Southward again [several illegible words] of his time [illegible] Given under my hand at Fredricksburgh [sic: Fredericksburg VA] this 22<sup>d</sup> day of July 1784. Thos. Barbee [Thomas Barbee BLWt258-300]
